Subject: The Remote Controller has been changed.

Symptom: The batteries run down in about two weeks. The standby current of the Remote Controller was too high at 1.3mA.

Solution: Replace the Remote Controller. (The Part number has not changed.) The improved remote can be identified by a blue label (dot) in the battery compartment. See the picture on the next page for details.
