



This is the basic schematic diagram, but the actual circuit may vary due to improvements in design.

1. RESISTOR:
Indicated in Δ , 1/4W, $\pm 5\%$ tolerance unless otherwise noted. W, 1/2W, M, M.L, (P), $\pm 1\%$, (G), $\pm 2\%$, (K), $\pm 10\%$ tolerance.
2. CAPACITORS:
Indicated in Δ (uF) (voltage/V) unless otherwise noted. p, pF; n, nF; without voltage is 50V except electrolytic capacitor.
3. VOLTAGE: $\square$ DC voltage (V) at no input signal
4. OTHERS:
 ϕ - Distinguishing point.
The Δ mark found on some component parts indicates the importance of the safety factor of the part. Therefore, when replacing, be sure to use parts of identical designation.
