System Information

The LCI In-Wall® column clamp part number 389787 should be utilized for installed In-Wall Slide-out systems only.

Resources Required

- Cordless or Electric Drill or Screw Gun
- Appropriate Drive Bit


Installation

1. Place the LCI In-Wall column clamp (Fig. 1A) on the inside of the slide system (Fig. 1B). The clamp should be flush to the top of the channel, against the bulb seal on the system and hang out over the wall.

NOTE: Use self-drilling screws or drill pilot holes.

- 2. Use #10 x $\frac{3}{4}$ " screws to attach the LCI In-Wall column clamp to the inside of the In-Wall system.
- 3. Use #10 screws to fasten the LCI In-Wall column clamp to the wall of the unit.
- **4.** Repeat steps 1 3 for the opposite side.

NOTE: Notches around the rivet heads are an indication that the clamp is placed correctly (Fig. 1C).
