

RESET TO FACTORY DEFAULTS

How to Recover Your WiFiRanger

WHEN SHOULD IT BE RESET?

In the case of forgetting your custom password, a factory reset is needed. Other cases may also require a factory reset, but this guide is primarily for those recovering their otherwise inaccessible WiFiRanger.

Examples of instances that require a factory reset



Password Forgotten - restores to changemenowXXXXX * Network Forgotten - restores to Pvt.WiFiRanger.XXXXX * Otherwise Inaccessible - may correct other settings

* XXXX IS FILLED WITH LAST FOUR DIGITS OF WFR ID, FOR EXAMPLE: 774067 WOULD BE PVT.WIFIRANGER.4067 AND CHANGEMENOW4067

COMPATIBILITY

The following reset method works with firmware versions 6.6.5+

RESET BUTTON NOTATION

The reset button on any WiFiRanger product is used only during the manufacturing process, and it will not reset the unit to factory defaults

STEP 1

Power unit and wait a couple minutes





STEP 2

Reboot router 3 times separated by various time intervals UNPLUG THEN *QUICKLY* PLUG BACK INTO POWER TO REBOOT



WAIT 2MIN 30SEC AFTER 1ST REBOOT



WAIT 3MIN 30SEC AFTER 2ND REBOOT



WAIT 3MIN 30SEC AFTER 3RD REBOOT



IT'S READY FOR ACTION!

STEP 3

Connect to WiFiRanger using default settings

DETERMINE XX AND YY FROM NETWORK BROADCAST OF YOUR SKY \triangle \Longrightarrow

NETWORK Pvt.WiFiRanger.XXYY
PASSWORD changemenowXXYY
CONTROL PANEL ADDRESS
10.1XX.YY.1:8080

FOR EXAMPLE

Pvt.WiFiRanger.4067

changemenow4067

10.140.67.1:8080
